For each event, entries are **limited** to 18 runs (test, trial and instinct combined). Test and trial runs will be given priority.

**Stock:** Boer and Boer-cross goats, horned, polled or dehorned, 3 goats/run.

HT will be in an outdoor sand round pen, 130' diameter

Instinct will be in the indoor arena, 50' x 50'

### Exhibitor Information: ENTERING THE SHOW

Enter by filling out the official entry forms and sending with correct fees to event secretary.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print the information on entry forms clearly and review the entry form carefully before submitting. Illegible, unsigned or otherwise incomplete entries will be returned. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms or entry forms without agreement and rules will be returned. BSCA will not refund duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the club's control after entries close. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing (email okay) prior to the close of entries. No entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Entries sent by USPS Priority, FedEx or other special delivery must be marked "NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED". Failure to ensure delivery without requiring signature will result in your entry being returned.

**Payment:** Make check or money order (USD only) payable to: **BSCA 2015**. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A collection fee will be added to the amount of any returned check. When you provide a check as payment, you authorize us to either use information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check. Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Calculate fees carefully; no refunds will be made if excess fees are submitted, and entries sent with insufficient fees will not be accepted.

**Eligibility, acceptance, and refunds:** BSCA may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.

**Confirmations:** If an email address is provided on the entry form, a confirmation of receipt will be sent via email. Final confirmations and judging program will be sent via e-mail soon after the draw. If you would like a hard copy of the final confirmation and judging program, please enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope.

**Eligibility, acceptance, bitches in season and refunds:** Bitches in season are eligible to compete and will run in catalog order in trials and at the end of their classes in tests. Please notify the Event Secretary at least ½ hour before judging begins if your bitch is in season.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

#### **Exhibitor Information: ALTERNATES**

When entry limits are reached, all additional entries received prior to closing will be added to the alternates list. The alternates list will be used to fill vacancies that occur in the drawn running order, with the first available alternate entry replacing the first vacancy in the class entered. If you do NOT wish to be on the alternate list, mark the "Decline Alternate List" box on the entry form. BSCA will refund entry fees for alternates whose dogs do not run.

Per Ch. 1, Sec. 13, of the Herding Regulations, "In tests and for move-ups from a test class to a trial class, alternate entries shall be given priority over dogs that are eligible to be moved-up. Within the trial classes, requests to move-up shall be given priority over alternate entries. Alternates will be permitted to run if there is an absentee in an earlier class (provided the alternate's class has not begun) which was not filled on the same course, same type of livestock and under the same Judge, or if a dog has been marked absent with the Event Secretary prior to the beginning of the alternate's class."

#### **Exhibitor Information: EXHIBITOR RESPONSIBILITIES**

**Assumption of risk:** BSCA, its officers and representatives, the Event Secretary, committee, site owner and livestock owner assume no responsibility for loss, damage or injuries sustained by spectators, exhibitors, exhibitors' property, and their dogs and assume no responsibility for injury to children. Children must be under the direct supervision of a responsible adult. Adults whose children under their care are found unattended, disturbing livestock or dogs, or in restricted areas, may be asked to leave the site.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Each Owner and Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound

by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed and submitted the entry form.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club’s show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All dogs present must be crated, held on leash, or otherwise restricted except when in the arena. Under no circumstance will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog’s performance in the arena. See Chapter 1, Sec. 20, of the AKC Herding Regulations.

Exhibitors may bring unentered dogs onto the trial grounds. No dogs except the working dog and stock handler’s dog are permitted near the working arena during test or trial runs. Dogs shall not be allowed to bark or cause any other disturbance which interferes with the working dog or with any livestock. Entrants are responsible for controlling and cleaning up after their dogs.

**Stock value and damages:** Replacement value of a goat is \$175.00. A minimum \$10 fee will be charged for treating minor injuries to goats. Handlers may be assessed \$15/hour of labor for repairs due to damage to fences or gates caused by rough handling of stock.

This Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for these events.

**Awards and Prizes**

BSCA reserves the right to make prize substitutions of equal or greater value in the event a specific listed prize is not available.

All awards are offered by the Belgian Sheepdog Club of America, except where noted. Qualifying scores are required for all awards.

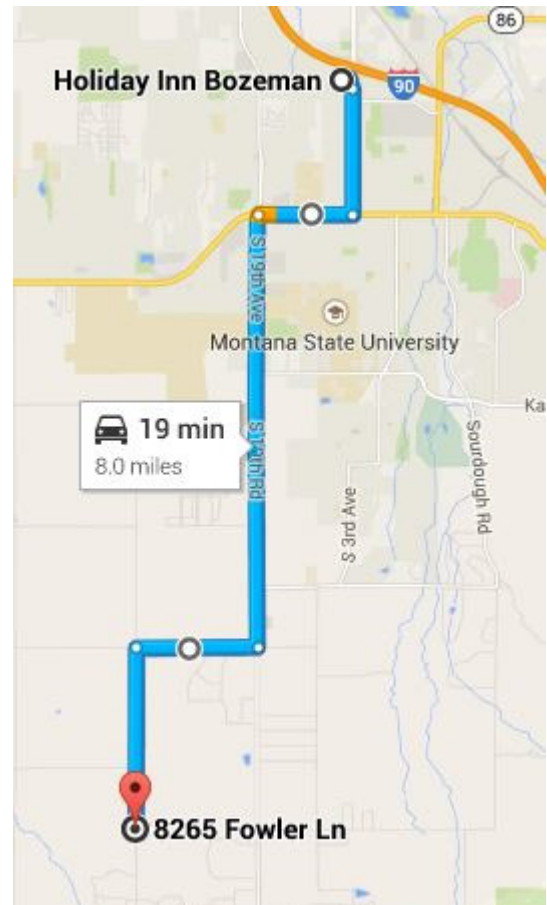

AGREEMENT

This agreement must be included with each entry.

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of this dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered on the reverse. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this trial, and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list for this trial, and on the entry form. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. The entry is submitted for acceptance on the foregoing representation and Agreement. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, American Belgian Malinois Club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner or leasor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury, or damage to this dog.

I (we) will pay for any livestock injuries or the replacement value in the event of death of any livestock cause by my (our) dog. In case of any injury to any stock caused by the dog entered, I (we) assume total responsibility for any damage. I (we) agree to pay the full market value of the injured animal in case of serious injury or veterinarian bill if the injury is slight.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.
